The June 25th activity meeting held on teleconference mode has been switched to the "Zoom" system from Jitsi. This may or may not be permanent but is a test to see if the Zoom can handle large amounts of check-ins compared to Jitsi.

Tests have found Jitsi works better if everyone mutes their video and audio when not in use for larger numbers. The Zoom system which is not free, is more widely used in industry. You must however download the Zoom software from the Zoom website and if you already have it on your computer, you <u>MUST</u> have latest version that has corrected a hacking issue.

Hopefully we will not need this for much longer and we can use the Eyeball mode which is totally free to use and features a snooze and chat mode built in...

You would think that "20-20" meant Clarity, Conciseness, Crystal Clear Vision, a Perfect Plan for the Future, etc etc....but no, the heading above in upside down letters is more indicative of what this year is like. And alas Field Day is another victim of our "Year of the Covid"....

There is no set rule against setting up a station in the field, but in the interest of public safety and social distancing we have decided to adapt to the ARRL's new 2020 only, rule change and do operating from our home stations and give affiliation credit to the MARC. The ARRL will give an aggregate score for the MARC from our logs sent in to the ARRL.

This will involve each of us entering a score for our operating and from what I have observed the easiest way is to use the ARRL Web based app...

Objective:

To contact as many stations as possible on the 160, 80, 40, 20,15and 10 Meter HF bands, as well as all bands 50 MHz and above, and to learn to operate in abnormal situations in less than optimal conditions. Field Day is open to all amateurs in the areas covered by the ARRL/RAC Field Organizations and countries within IARU Region 2. DX stations residing in other regions may be contacted for credit, but are not eligible to submit entries.

Each claimed contact must include contemporaneous direct initiation by the operator on both sides of the contact. Initiation of a contact may be either locally or by remote.


Bands: 160, 80, 40, 20,15 and 10 Meter HF bands, as well as all bands 50 MHz and above, All modes.




FROM ROB K1RCT, TIPS ON SETTING N1MM TO FD PARAMETERS

- 3) Scroll to & click "Change Your Station Data...".






- Pop-up window that reads, "Edit Station Information".

- 2) Press the "OK" button


