


### From John W1DQ

In our hobby I just happen to prefer CW DX. I was referred to it in QSO with a high-speed French CW operator. In that it was "catchy" and given the recent interest in CW revival, I thought I would pass it on to Key Klix. While it might reflect the opinions of a few, it does not reflect my own.

Replacing the Pony Express horses, CW became the earliest means of communication using a signal conducting means (wire or rf energy) and a way of periodically modulating the signal (key or modulator). Since then and over the 64 years that I have been licensed, the technology has continually advanced, often by amateurs themselves. Microprocessors and software have replaced hand assembled components and soldering. If allowed, one might go so far as to configure a system to automatically detect signals out of the noise and complete QSO's without the otherwise intercession of a control operator.


The beauty of amateur radio is there is room for all interests; choose your own. W1DQ

#### From the editor:




